ABOUT SRMPS

Sukh Ram Memorial Public School started in the year 2001 at the ancestral home of the Aryas' in village Kalirawan. Today the School is located in a new complex which stands proudly on the main road. It is a co-educational English medium school affiliated with CBSE and the first graduating class has earned their senior higher secondary certificate in 2012. The school started out as a Hindi Medium school with the thinking that rural kids might have difficulty to pull along in an English Medium school, however, realizing that English Medium is a necessity for the modern education, the medium was changed to English after 3 years.

Spread over 8 and a half acres, the school has 48,000 square feet of covered area as a three-storey building. Mr. and Mrs. Arya donated 5 and a half acres of land from their own agricultural holdings, and bought the remaining three acres.

In addition to a traditional classroom curriculum, the students at Sukh Ram Memorial Public School also benefit from learning about Indian culture and taking part in physical education, yoga, public speaking and gardening etc. A typical school day is of around 6 hours, and the school year is also comprised of more than 225 teaching days.

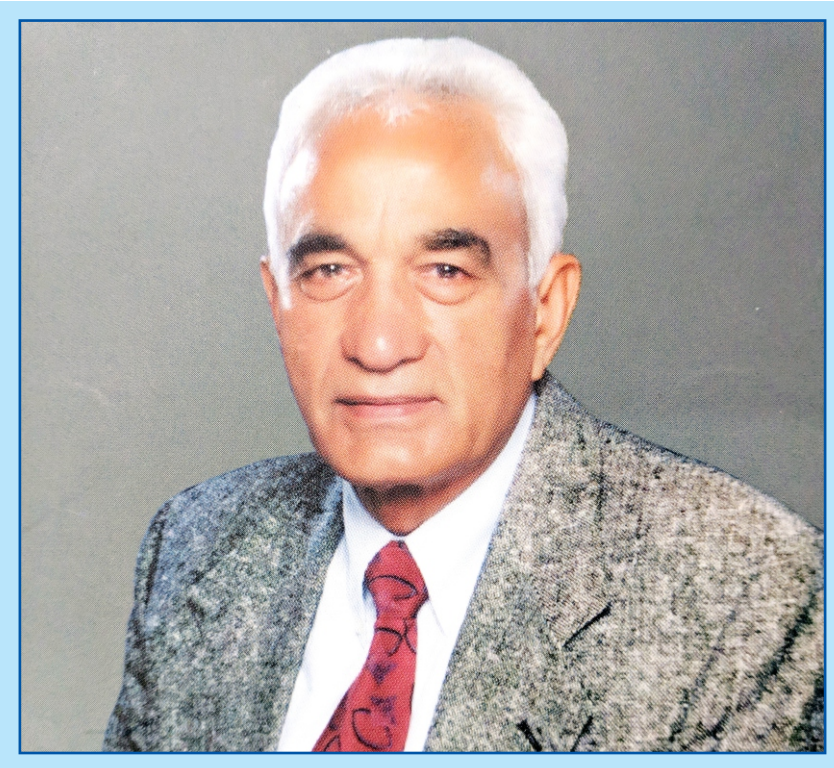
The Aryas, who dream of making the Sukh Ram Memorial Public School one of the best schools in the region, have thus far spent over \$2 millions of their own money and provide for the yearly deficit in running expenses to the tune of 20-25 lakhs.

General Expectations From Parents

Now days the school has become the most important agency for formal education but the home wields a powerful influence on children in molding their personalities. But teachers and parents are equally responsible for the education of the child, so maximum co-operation between the parents and the school authorities is desired to secure all that is best for the education of their wards. For this the diary is the best link between the teachers and the parents/ guardians. The parents are requested to go through it carefully and make a daily check of the home work given to the child and done by him/her by signing the diary at the appropriate place. They are also requested to offer their suggestions on the pages meant for the purpose. It is hoped that parents will extend their full co-operation in this joint venture of educating the young ones.

In order to secure all that is best in the education of your children the maximum co-operation between parents and the school Authorities is desired. We earnestly recommend that parents or guardians should look into their children's school dairies or hand book every day and see to it that the lessons and home work assigned for the next day are done neatly. Children should be encouraged to cultivate the habit of neatness and all slovenliness should be firmly disapproved. The school calendar or other circulars whenever issued are to be regularly checked & signed by you from time to time. If you feel that your children are not making the desired progress., the Principal should be contacted. Private tuitions are strongly discouraged. If there is a real need of a private tutor make sure after consulting with the Principal, that you engage one who is familiar with the methods adopted in this school. All Private tuitions are for the full session and not to be taken on a temporary basis. Criticism of your children's teacher or school in their presence should be avoided,

because it causes them to lose their respect for the teachers with a consequent failure to learn from the teacher. If you have legitimate complaint, see the Principal early to sort out the matter. Encourage your ward to become useful members of society. Encourage self-help and study. They should be taught to keep their house, notebooks, books and clothes neat and tidy. They should polish their own shoes and be habitual to do their work with their own hands.

Educational Goals

The school endeavours to provide education in a stress-free atmosphere. Maintaining a teacher pupil ratio of 1:20, the school encourages a spirit of enquiry among the students rather than information oriented pedantic learning. While encouraging a spirit of initiative, independence and self-reliance, a value-based undercurrent is maintained in keeping with the vision, mission and values of the school. Every effort is directed to enrich the students with knowledge of the rich cultural heritage of the country. The general environment of the school is woven round the age-old reverence for the teachers, elders, a spirit of tolerance and love for the motherland.

The school synthesizes the best of the oriental and the occidental education to make a good and true Indian and World Citizen. The school has evolved a pattern of 'Holistic' education, which aims at developing the intellect, the physique and social consciousness of the growing child. The school strives to instil devotion, loyalty and 'never give in' determination into the beings of the learners. The basic aim underlines the formation of a resolute character, a well-groomed personality with appropriate thoughts full of reason towards meaningful actions.

Academics

As the school was upgraded to Sr. Secondary level by CBSE at the beginning 2009 only, classes for Science, Humanities and Commerce streams are in progress. This has proved to be a boon for the female students as the parents hailing from an orthodox background find it unsuitable to send their daughters to cities for further education. Prior to this, the female students desirous of pursuing their studies in science especially commerce were finding themselves helpless for want of a Sr. Secondary School in the vicinity having Science and Commerce Streams. Students here, may opt for Physical Education, Computer (ICT) and Music (Vocal as well as Instrumental) as additional subjects. School has a well qualified staff for all subjects.

Method of Teaching

We maintain a very healthy student-teacher ratio of 1:25 in all our classes. This not only helps the students to better interact with their teachers but also increases the effectiveness of the curriculum. Innovative teaching aids are used by our teachers to make the subjects interesting and easy. We believe in participative method rather than the rote method.

School Management Committee

The SMC is a team of 20 visionary people who are always ready to help the school administration in fulfilling the vision and mission of the school. The SMC has been constituted as per the new bye laws of CBSE. Half of its members are female which makes it even more caring. All the members go beyond the call of their duty and are available round the clock. Their selfless service inspires everyone associated with school to give their best. The SMC has further

constituted four more sub committees to look after the interests of all stakeholders i.e., Sexual Harassment, Child Abuse Management, Grievance Redressal and Disaster Management & Child Safety. The list of members of all committees is available on school website www.srmpskalirawan.edu.in



Faculty

In the words of Brad Henry, "A good teacher can inspire hope, ignite the imagination and instill the love of learning". All the 50 plus teaching staff have the same vision and approach. The school has dedicated, versatile and dynamic teachers who always try to incorporate new ideas and methods of teaching. The excellent board results are the proof of their hard work and sincerity. They always try to bring out the best in students. They are a team of highly skilled and multi faceted individuals who always set high standards for their students and do not settle for anything less.



School Rules

1. Students should come to school in time and in a proper uniform.
2. Students are expected to take care of their books, note books, stationary, personal belongings etc. The school is not responsible for any loss.
3. Students should not bring cash or other expensive articles in the school.
4. No student will leave the school premises during school hours including recess without the permission of the Principal or approval of the Class In charge.
5. Parents/Guardian can meet students during school hours only with the permission of the Principal.
6. Students desiring exemption from uniform for a day or two must bring application form their parents/Guardians giving reasons for exemption otherwise they will be fined Rs. 5/- Per day.
7. Students should not damage the school property. Any damage will be covered by realizing the cost of repairs. An additional fine up to Rs. 100/- can also be imposed. Students noticing the damage being done must bring it to the notice of the Class Teacher or the Principal.
8. Children should not run, shout or whistle in the school premises.
9. Parents/Guardians are not permitted to walk straight into class rooms to see their wards or teachers during the class hours.
10. Students are responsible for their conduct inside and outside the school.
11. Every student is expected to take proper care of his/her desk and chair.
12. Students are expected to take part in games and other extracurricular activities.
13. Presence is compulsory on the following occasions :- (i)

Independence day. (ii) Republic day. (iii) House Competitions. (iv) Annual Day.

14. Progress report of the child is to be signed by the Parents/Guardian and sent back to the school next day.
15. Parents/Guardians will check the school diary of their ward daily to monitor/know his/her regular progress.

Leaves Rules

1. All applications for leave must be duly signed by the parents/guardians.
2. If a student absents himself/herself without leave application for more than 10 days, his/her name will be struck off the rolls.

Library

1. A student can get only one book issued at a time from the library.
2. Reference books will not be issued to the students.
3. Books should be returned on the due date otherwise a fine of Rs. 1/- for general books and Rs. 5/- for textbooks per day will be levied.
4. Students should not mark, underline or deface the books otherwise fine would be levied on him/her.
5. Students should not bring their personal books in library.

Fees

The fees counter will remain open on all working days. The last date of payment of fee is the 10th of each month after that a late fee fine of Rs. 5/- per day is charged from each defaulter. If the fee is not paid by the 20th of a month, the name of the student is struck off the school roll. Re-admission may, however, be considered at the discretion of the Principal. Fee for the month of May and June is required to be paid by the 10th of May and for the months of February

and March by the 10th of February.

The parents/guardian must retain the receipts issued to them as a proof of payment and produce them, when asked.

Note : Fee and any others due once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Admission Procedure

The Registration process starts with effect from 1st January every year. Students are admitted to LKG only. However in case of transfer of a parent / guardian, a student can be admitted to classes other than LKG as a special case. Students seeking admission are required to fill up a form attached with this prospectus. Applications received on or before 15th March every year are considered for admission subject to vacancy. Ordinarily no admissions are accepted to classes other than LKG. Regular admissions will be made after the annual exams of the school in March. Admission will be granted strictly on the basis of Merit and Interview.

Age For Admission :

L.K.G. : Three years or more as on the 1st of April of that academic session. There will be no entrance test for this class.

Registration :

For admission to the school Registration-cum-Admission Form, available with the prospectus, is to be submitted at the school office along with Registration Fee (non-refundable).

Admission Test and Interview :

Admission to Class UKG and above will be on the basis of a test & interaction between teachers and the child.

Admission to Class 10+1 will be provisional at the start of the Academic Session. It will be confirmed after the declaration of CBSE/Board results.

- Registration for admission to school is NOT in any way a guarantee for admission.
- School reserves the right to admission.

Documents Required For Admission

- Attested Photocopy of Date of Birth Certificate.
- Original School Leaving Certificate from previous school, countersigned by District Education Officer/CBSE authorities. (Not required for admission to class LKG)
- Photocopy of the Mark-sheet of the last examination taken. (Not required for admission to class LKG).
- Proof of Address.
- Two passport size photographs of child.
- One passport size photo each of mother and father or guardian.
- Blood group report.





WITHDRAWALS & TERMINATION

Withdrawals

- A parent, desirous of withdrawing his child, will have to inform the Principal one month in advance in writing, failing which, one month's dues will be deducted from the security deposits.
- School Leaving Certificate will be furnished after a week from the day of receiving written request from the parents/guardian and only after obtaining No Dues Certificate from the Accounts Branch of the school office, Library & Tuck-shops, as per rules.

Academic Session

The academic session begins in the month of April of each year and ends in March of the following year. Every endeavour is made by the school to help children to improve their performance and a reasonable progress is possible only with the child's co-operation and parent's encouragement. Should a student consistently performs poorly, his/her result will be declared as EIOP.

Termination

A student may be terminated from the school. His/her name will be struck off Scholar Register on the following grounds without any prior notice.

- a. Non-remittance of School Dues as per rules.
- b. Disciplinary grounds.
- c. Unsatisfactory progress in studies, resulting in repeated detention in the previous class.
- d. Shortage of attendance for the academic year.
- e. Absence from school for continuous 10 days without any prior information.
- f. Any other reason, as may be deemed fit by the Principal.

School Timing

Summer 7.45 a.m. to 2.00 p.m.
Winter 8.45 a.m. to 3.00 p.m

House System

The school is divided into four Houses:

- (1) Swami Vivekananda House
- (2) Bhagat Singh House
- (3) Neta Ji Subhash Chander Bose House
- (4) Chander Shekhar Azad House

These houses are purposefully named after eminent people of our country to motivate the students. The House teachers motivate maximum number of students to take part in Inter-House and Inter-School Competitions.

Each house is under the charge of a House Master/Mistress and has its own House Captains (Boys & Girls), Sports Captain (Boys & Girls), Activity Incharge & Discipline Incharge who are responsible for the tone of discipline in that house. They are selected on the basis of their academic record, discipline, positive attitude, sense of responsibility and leadership qualities. The Best House Trophy is awarded to the best performing house in all peripheries every year.



Promotion

1. The final assessment of the student for promotion shall be decided on the basis of the annual record of the student for a maximum of 100 marks in each subject distributed as under:

2. If a student fails to appear in any exam due to his/her illness (for which a medical certificate is to be submitted), or any unforeseen emergency, he/she may be allowed proportionate credit for such an examination for the purpose of final assessment for promotion to the next class. For example a student who has not appeared in a particular examination on medical ground with certificate, the total marks obtained by him/her on the basis of his/her annual record may be worked out for the maximum of remaining marks for the exams actually taken. 3. No student will be allowed for re-examination if he/she misses any exam.

4. The answer script of the Annual examination will be shown to the Student /Parents after depositing the prescribed fee.

5. Children representing school in an activity during the examination time will be given proportionate weightage in the evaluation.

6. The decision of the examination committee will be final & binding in case of any dispute.





Scholarships

Ch. M.S. Jaglan Memorial Topper Scholarship:

Two students each from class 1st to 9th are selected on the basis of their performance in academics throughout for the whole session. They are conferred with scholarship sponsored by Mr. Anil Jaglan in the memory of his Late father Ch. Maha Singh Jaglan.

Dr. Ghansi Ram Verma Mathematics Scholarship:

The scholarship funded by Mr. R.S. Arya & Mrs. Santosh Arya is the honour of renowned mathematician and philanthropist Dr. Ghansi Ram Verma, Professor Emeritus, University of Island USA. Two Students each from class 5th to 8th are selected on the basis of their performance in the written test. The test comprises of 100 multiple choice questions from the subject of mathematics and mental ability. The questions are based on the syllabus of mathematics of the previous classes. This test is generally conducted in the month of April every year. Only the bonafide students of school are eligible to appear in the test.

Harish Pal Memorial Science Scholarship:

Two bonafide students each from Secondary classes are conferred scholarship of Rs.4000/- and Rs. 3500/- for getting 1st and 2nd position respectively based on the merit of the result of a competitive examination to be held every year, one month after the annual exam. The test will comprise of MCQ from the syllabi of the science subject of the previous classes. Amount of scholarship will be for the forthcoming session subject to the fact that the student shows keen interest and progress in studies during the next higher class.

Ch. M.S. Jaglan Memorial G.K. Scholarship :

In the fond memory of Late Chaudhary Maha Singh Jaglan, a General Knowledge Test is organized in the month of October in the premises of SUKH RAM MEMORIAL PUBLIC SCHOOL, KALIRAWAN

(HISAR). Any student can participate in this examination after depositing the requisite fee and getting his/her name forwarded by the Principal of the school in which he/she is studying.

Categories:

There are three categories for this exam i.e., Primary (up to 5th Class), Middle (6th to 8th Class) and Secondary (9th and 10th Class). Three students from each category (details given below) shall be selected to get the Scholarship.

Syllabus:

Awareness of Current & Sports Events, Knowledge of History of India, Freedom Struggle, Geography, General Science, Political Science, Civics, Economics, History of Haryana & its Rich Heritage and other miscellaneous facts. The level of General Knowledge to be tested will be according to the standard and syllabus of Primary, Middle and Secondary Classes of C.B.S.E.

Organizing Committee

A committee, comprising of the Principal of SRMPS Kalirawan as convener and three senior teachers of Science, Maths and S.Sc. (may be from other schools and approved by the MC of MSJMGK Trophy), will be responsible for setting of question paper, conduct of written test and compilation of results.

Medium of Examination and Design of Question Paper:

Medium of exam will be English only. The question paper will contain 100 Multiple Choice Questions of one mark each. There will be no negative marking for wrong answers.

Answer Key:

The answer key of question papers for all three categories will be uploaded on website- www.srpmskalirawan.com after the exam.

Exam Fee:

A nominal fee of Rs. 50/- per participant is charged to restrict the number of participants. A candidate can deposit it directly in SRMPS, Kalirawan along with the exam form or can get it forwarded through the Principal of the school in which he/she is studying.

Eligibility: -

Any student of the schools of the area/region can participate in this competition with its Principal's permission. Participating Schools will send the names, category and the fee to SRMPS Kalirawan. Students can also deposit Entry Form (Annexure C) directly to SRMPS, Kalirawan with the requisite fee.

Date/Timings/Venue of Examination:

Exam is held on 3rd Sunday of October every year from 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. in the premises of SRMPS, Kalirawan. The participants must reach the venue half an hour earlier by 9:30 a.m. and must bring their I-cards (issued by school) for identification.

The answer sheets will be checked on the day of exam and the list of students selected to receive the scholarships is displayed on the notice board & uploaded on website of school. The winners are awarded on the Annual Day of the school in November.

Harish Paul Memorial Board Topper Scholarship: (for students of class XI & XII)

This scholarship is also funded by the Mr. R.S. Arya & Mrs. Santosh Arya is the memory of their beloved friend, Er. Harish Paul. The students of class XI who score more than 95% in the CBSE Board exams of class are awarded a scholarship equal to 100% of their tuition fee. Also a scholarship equal to 50% of tuition fee will be awarded to students will get more than 85% in the board exams. They will also be eligible to get the same amount in class XII if they score more than 80% marks in class XI.

Mrs. Gumani Devi Memorial Sports Scholarship:

Also funded by Mr. R.S. Arya & Mrs. Santosh Arya is the memory his mother Late Smt. Gumani Devi Ji. The bonafide students of school will get a scholarship of Rs. 5100/- if they get a gold/silver/bronze medal at the national level. The students who will get a gold/silver/bronze medal at state/zonal/cluster level be conferred with a scholarship of Rs. 2100/- each.





Co-Curricular Activities

Co-curricular activities help a student in developing his/her personality. Therefore all our activities are focused in that direction. Be it inter-house competitions, which are contested with full vigor or just plain news reading in the morning assembly. We have just one aim in mind to encourage our students to become participative, overcome shyness, and exhibit confidence. The morning assembly is conducted in rotation by every class. Many inter-house competitions like Recitation, Story Telling, Debates, Calligraphy, Rangoli, Dance, Drawing, Greeting Card Making, Extempore, English Play, Spellathon, Story Writing, GK Quiz, Mathematics & Science Quiz etc are conducted as per the schedule given in the CCA Calendar.

Inter House & Inter School Competitions

Competitions make one strive for the best. From the cradle to the final exit, one has to face competitions to prove oneself and learn valuable lessons. Inter-House competitions at School are organized with a view to channelise the leadership potentials of the students to the optimum.

The school conducts various Inter-House competitions as per fixed schedule during the academic year. Inter-School competitions make participants toil round the year.

School Functions

School functions are an integral part of school curriculum. Several functions are held every year. These functions include Annual Prize Distribution, Annual Sports Day, Investiture Ceremony, Republic Day, Independence Day, Teacher's Day, Children's Day, School Exhibition, School Fete etc. A rich flavour of music, dance and orchestra are the highlights of our functions. School exhibition unfolds the potential of students. It helps the students to imbibe the value of hard work and unleash their own creativity. The spirit of 'I can do' channelizes one's energies and helps one to set a goal in life. The

school appears as a colourful mini museum conceiving all sorts of variety in itself. These school functions manifest practical implication of knowledge and provide a suitable platform to the students to prove their latent talents.



Parent-Teacher Meeting

Parents' contribution towards fulfilling our aims and dreams need not be mentioned as we believe in making parents our partners in imparting education. Parents must understand that we cater to the need of all children without any favour to a particular group or individuals. For us each child is born free and equal in all respects. Towards this end the school follows laid down rules & regulations and it is expected that these be followed in letter & spirit.

We do not favour parents/guardians to disturb their child when the classes are in progress. We also do not favour children to go on any kind of leave on false grounds. The dates for P.T.M. are declared well in advance and mentioned in students almanac.

Parent-Founder Meeting

To make the curriculum comparatively more practical and user friendly, the founders of the school meet the parents at least once a year in October/November to feel the pulse of all and sundry. They collect the valuable suggestions and address to the genuine problems of the parents particularly the needy. Founders will scale any length for the welfare of all students so that nobody in the village is forced to drop out before reaching his/her destination in the field of education.

Library Facilities

The School maintains a library having over 6000 books on different subjects. It is replete with a vast range of reference books. We always encourage students to cultivate a habit of reading. Towards that end students will be asked to read a certain number of books to increase their awareness. Every year many books on various topics & subjects are added to the stock. Library subscribes various magazine & journals along with national dailies.

Computer Lab Facilities

The School has a modern computer lab with internet connectivity to ensure that our students take advantage of globalization of

education. It helps young children to start getting integrated with modern means of teaching aids.





Science Lab Facilities

To provide a practical approach to learning and complement the conventional stereo type classroom environment, the school has well equipped Physics, Chemistry and Biology laboratories. Students are provided with requisite aids for the project and practical work that will help in 'learning by doing'. The school has a separate Composite Science Laboratory specifically designed to cater to the needs of students upto class eight

Mathematics Laboratory

The Mathematics Laboratory is one of the most advanced and unique facilities of the school. The mathematics laboratory is equipped with computers, software and facilities where the students are made to work on carefully designed activities and projects which enable them to see the relevance of Mathematics to real life. It helps in developing the skills like sharing, thinking, reasoning and analytical skills.

Games & Sports Facilities

"Healthy mind in a healthy body" is what we believe in, we encourage students to participate in outdoor & indoor games. Our students regularly take part in various games and sports events at district, state and national level conducted by education department. They also participate in CBSE games at cluster, zonal and national games. All facilities viz 400m track, Basketball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Volleyball, Handball and Football over a stretch of 4.5 acres of land are available. The facility for Indoor games like Table Tennis, Chess, Carrometc are also available in school. Students winning Gold/Silver/Bronze medals at various levels are eligible for Mrs Gumani Devi Sports Scholarship.

Work Experience, Art Edu. Dance & Music Facility

To explore the hidden talents and to encourage the children to sprout out, School has a large variety of subjects as a part of Art



Education and Work Experience. The facilities are available for Music-Vocal and Instrumental, Dance-Folk, Classical and Western, a variety of art and craft. Aesthetically designed dance and music rooms provide an adequate thrust to the cultural drive of the students. A well-maintained Activity Block provides the requisite extra-curricular blend in the pursuit of learning. A specially designed Activity Room for Kinder Garten students help them learn different subjects by play way method.

Transport Facility

The school has a fleet of 11 buses which ply on routes covering over 30 villages & towns in the nearby surrounding area for the transportation of children from town to the school and back. The bus routes and pick up points, are decided by the school. This information is displayed on the notice board of the school and also at the school website www.holyangelhisar.com. Changes, if any, are notified to the students. For availing transport facility for their ward, parents must clearly write at the appropriate column in the Admission Form.

Parents are responsible for escorting their ward, to and fro, from the respective pick-up points. The transport facility is availed by the parents at their own risk and responsibility. To discontinue the transport facility, parents must inform the principal one month in advance in writing, failing which, one month's transport fee will be charged.

A student can be debarred from availing transport facility in case of indiscipline.





Teacher Enrichment Programme

Teachers are among the basic components working relentlessly towards the realization of the multiple objectives of School. It is important that this segment of the school remains well-informed about the latest developments in their respective fields. To enable the teachers perform to the tune of the time, the school hosts regular Faculty Development Programmes/Seminars on each subject to update teachers' knowledge and to enhance their teaching skills. While such programmes make us believe that education is a never-ending process, they also provide opportunities to the teachers to educate themselves, refine and update their knowledge. The Faculty Development Programmes/Seminars have in-house experts as well as those from outside. School also nominates teachers regularly to attend the various capacity building programmes organized by CBSE Centre of Excellence.

Tour & Excursions

To hone the skills of learning through travelling, a comprehensive schedule for tours/treks etc. is planned for the students every year. This not only helps the students learn things in an easier, lasting and lucid manner but it also provides them with an opportunity of self-management. Tours, Treks, ,Excursions are regularly organized by the school. Faculty members accompany the students for their guidance and to ensure their safety.

Further, to give the students a firsthand information, local visits to working sites viz. Telephone Exchange, Post Office, Banks, Hospital, Laboratories, CCSHAU, GJU S&T, Army Cantt., Industries are also carried out. Such visits not only educate the students but also provide a healthy and welcome change from the monotony of the school routine.

Student Development Programme

Resource persons are invited from outside to conduct Seminars and Workshops for students in issues concerning the healthy and an all round development of students. Extension lectures related to subjects are also delivered to them. Some of the topics dealt with are career counselling, stress management, positive thinking, healthy living, learning skills etc.





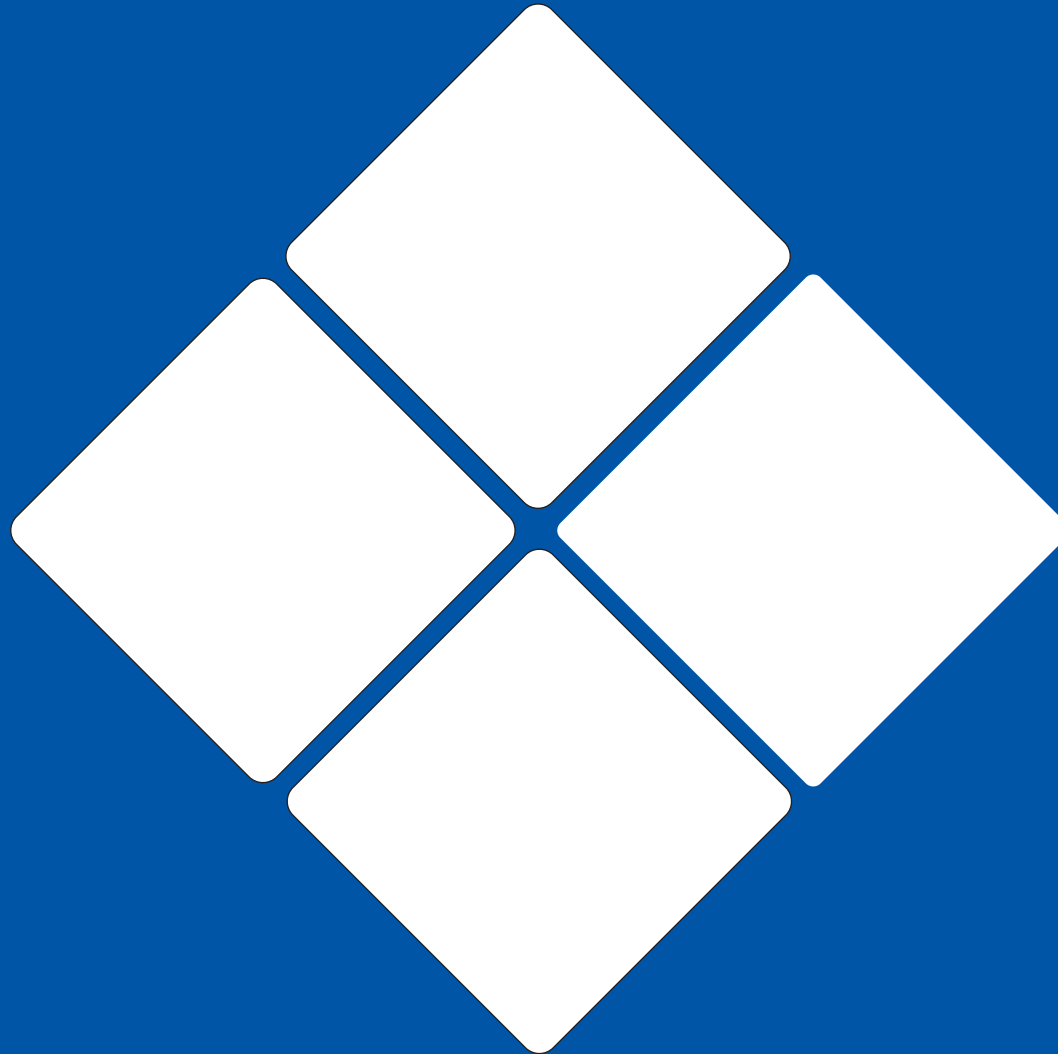
